SCCNH Drivers School and AutoX Event #2: On April 26th we had 22 students and 6 instructors for the Drivers School at NHMS. Bill was very pleased with the format and how everything went. It was split into two groups. It might be a good idea to have an Intermediate and Advanced group next year. We pretty much kept the same course on Sunday except for a few changes. We had 42 entries for the AutoX. We had 6 people attend from NEDrift. The event went very well with 5 runs because of the rain in the morning, on-course activity and work assignments. We will need to work on the trailer for repairs and seal up the roof. The timing is so awesome – we had a bit of a learning curve but once we got use to it – it just ran like a clock. Pre-registration was a great help and moved the registration line along quicker. We had a tent outside the trailer to collect money and then they checked in at the trailer to confirm the # and class. One thing we would like to have is a PA system or something for announcements. There were 6 drifters that attended and there were some that they did not abide by the rules. It is a difficult mix to have them at the AutoX. We think they might have had the wrong idea of what to expect. Howard and Ryan will connect before the next AutoXs.

Next AutoX event at NHMS will be Sunday, June 1st.

SCCNH Mt. Ascutney Hillclimb May 16-18th: 18 drivers are pre-registered todate. Ryan says there are 4 drifters that are signed up with a possible 12 more (10 is the limit). Bill will be bringing radios (or loaners) for the event and he will be there on Friday and they will be charged and ready to go.
