Call to Order: SCCNH President Howard Roundy called the first SCCNH monthly meeting of 2010 to order at 7:00 PM.

Treasurer's Report: George presented the financial standings for SCCNH: We have \$10,516.43 in the Money Market account, \$4,289.31 in the regular checking account, \$418.24 in the Pay Pal checking account and no activity on the PayPal online account (balance is still \$35.35) for a total of \$15,259.33. George reported that there were some outstanding trophy bills that needed to be paid from last fall. **Motion to accept the Treasurer's report was made by David Girardo and seconded by Charlie Parsons.** *Approved* – *Passed*

Membership Report: We have 15 members and 15 Lifetime members for a total of 30 for 2010.

Sponsorship Program: It is still early; however, Precision Imports of Manchester might be interested in sponsoring the first Auto Cross event. David also reported that he has a company working on a T-shirt design and we can either sell those or give them away. Drew mentioned that there is a SCCNH member who is in the silk-screen business in case we want to contact him.

Programs/Events:

- AutoCross Report: We are in need of an Auto Cross event chairman. Howard has contacted NHMS for the 2010 Auto Cross contract. Budget is on hold for now. We did purchase a display monitor that was on sale during the holidays.
- Hill Climb Budget for Spring/Mt. Ascutney event: Drew presented a budget for the Spring event. Motion to accept the Hill Climb Spring event budget was made by Dave Burden and seconded by George Young. Approved Passed

<u>Hill Climb 2010 Entry Fee</u>: **Motion was made by Dave Burden to keep the Hill Climb entry fee the same as last year; seconded by George Young.** *Approved – Passed*
