3.3 Practice Procedure:

All competing vehicles must be able to get to the start line, and start without assistance. Assistance is considered any help from crew or other competitors. This includes practice. The start at half way practice and staging is on an incline. After start command is given you have 30 seconds to start, a rolling start will be used. No service personnel will be allowed at half way practice. No service personnel are allowed beyond staging area at base of mountain.

After the first practice run, the competitors will be lead down to a turnaround spot. When practicing the top, the turnaround will be below the start area. There will be two way traffic between the turnaround spot and the start area. If you choose to go to the bottom you are done for the day. When practicing the bottom this turnaround will be the paddock.
